

SO2 "Jack Spring" not approved for use

Well, it had looked so good. The spring had passed its first MPA (micro-particle analysis) test during the summer and we were very optimistic about passing the second and final test during the "wet" season. Unfortunately, the 2nd MPA got a rating of "high moderate" susceptibility to contamination from surface water connection and the Department of Health revoked its provisional approval it had granted last summer. This source has been taken off line and we don't expect to be able to use it unless it receives additional filtration as a surface water source.

Pressure episodes on 115th and Cove Road

Monday, March 7th, 2011

We have been experiencing intermittent pressure problems on Cove Road and 115th. there was an initial problem associated with the draining and refilling of the main reservoir on 156th street. This draining was necessary to change some internal piping. The episodic nature of the problem has been traced to a failing pressure pump that was not able to sustain the required pressure users are needing.
